Mid-year DIBELS report. Roughly, 82 students aren't at benchmark. 86% are. First grade and Second grade are tricky since the benchmarks change every testing time but in 3rd grade. We always seem to dip in the winter. Teachers think the passages are a little harder for this testing round. SRI is what we're using for our goals because it's not timed and it still tests some growth and 75% proficient is our goal and we're currently at 86%

Discussion of School Improvement Plan (SIP) and STL funds. We're over the Trustlands Plan.

School Safety brought up by Trudy. Asking for 2 crossing guards at the Southwest intersection and suggested solar powered flashing stop signs. Educating parents with letters home may help. Officers presence may help as well. We need to discuss a SNAP plan (safe walking) at some point and the city wants to be involved in that discussion to see what else we need them to do. We'll put that on our March agenda
