# **Option 1: 8th Grade Electives**

Chorus 8	1	Course for boys and girls in vocal music
Guitar	1	Introduction to guitar performance
Art 8	1	Course in art appreciation, principles & creation
Ceramics 8	1	Course in creating ceramics and prints
Intro to Theatre	1	Introduces students to the arts of theater including acting, directing, playwriting and design.
Journalism	1	Develop school publications, school digital magazines, daily announcements, podcasts.

### **Option 2: Band and Orchestra**

For students interested in music, Spring Creek Middle School offers a variety of classes for those who wish to participate in band or orchestra.

## Beginning Orchestra Level I

Beginning orchestra is for students who have not been involved with Mountain West Strings or had private lessons. Students will learn the basics of instrument position, note reading, scale and finger patterns, ear training and basic tone production and bowing technique.

### Beginning Orchestra Level II

Must have taken  $4^{th} - 6^{th}$  grade orchestra or private lessons. Students will review and strengthen ear training and playing in an ensemble, reading and demonstrating increasingly more difficult finger patterns and scales including G, D, C, A, F and related minor keys.

### Beginning Orchestra Level III

Must have taken 4 years of orchestra with proficiency in the keys of C, G, D, A, F, Bb, Eb. Students will learn to recognize by sound and sight major and minor intervals, understand the circle of 5ths, key signatures and play increasingly difficult music both technically and musically.

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### Beginning Band Level I (Woodwinds, Brass, Percussion)

Students taking band select either woodwinds, brass, or percussion as their elective course for 7<sup>th</sup> grade. These are beginning courses that teach the basic fundamentals of how to play the instrument correctly, how to read music, and how to play together in an ensemble.

- Woodwinds: flute, clarinet, oboe, bassoon, saxophone.
- Brass: trumpet, horn, euphonium, trombone, tuba.
- Percussion: all mallet keyboard instruments and drums. No prior music experience is needed for these classes.

#### **Beginning Band Level II**

Students must have taken Beginning Band Level I. Continue building skills in technique, music literacy, and ensemble playing. Students who had a beginning band at another school may take this course.

#### **Beginning Band Level III**

Students must have taken Beginning Band Level I and II. Continue building skills in technique, music literacy, and ensemble playing. Students who took a beginning band at another school may take this course.
