- SRI tests- Current school goal is that 77 percent of students will be on grade level or above by year end. Currently we are at 73 percent, up from 63 percent in the fall.
- Trustland Budget- see attached budget. We are on track for spending, the bulk of the remaining dollars will be used for aides. Some of what was budgeted for computers may be needed for aides as well.
- Dibels- As a school we are showing improvement across all grade levels. Composite scores show growth as a school overall.
- Trustlands- We will need a second goal for Trustlands in 2018-2019. Some discussion was held regarding the use of a beginning and end of year math assessment, or other type of standardized test. It is recommended that everyone look at the Trustlands site for more ideas for a possible second goal. It might be possible to create a STEM or writing goal as well.
- School Improvement Plan- SRI, Writing, and Math are goals for our school. We are on target for SRI, and writing. Math is ongoing.
- Science- STEM Fest planned for March 22nd, in place of the PTA Science Fair. Grade level science/math activity will be taught at school during the day parents will then visit the school that evening to solve the challenge presented in class with their students. State of Utah has a STEM Bus that can visit schools, this is a possibility for future events.
- Other- Hats Off Award- applications are available for parents to complete. This is a way to recognize an outstanding teacher in our school.
